Description: Repair torn window mesh side sliding window

Removing the handle

- 1 Remove rubber retaining section from around damaged window mesh
- 2 Remove mesh and any dirt/dust - Clean glass with window cleaner,
- 3 Trim replacement mesh oversize to allow for final trimming
- 4 Starting at the centre of the window, align the mesh over the frame
- 5 Using the retaining rubber, push both the mesh and rubber into the groove - Keeping mesh taught.

Note: Some force will be required to push the rubber fully home - Ensure there is adequate support and protection under the window

- 6 Repeat the actions in 5 above around the frame keeping the mesh taught as you progress.
- 7 Trim off excess mesh around periphery
